ATN/FP-14161-GY-FOREST CARBON PARTNERSHIP FACILITY PROJECT IN GUYANA**

The Government of Guyana/Ministry of Natural Resources has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB), toward the cost of the Forest Carbon Partnership Facility (FCPF) Project in Guyana and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services for a **REDD+ Legal Specialist**.

The Project Executing Unit now invites all eligible **individuals** to indicate their interest.

The objectives of the consultancy is to conduct training and education on the interpretation and implementation of natural resources policy, legislation and guidelines, in the context of REDD+. As such the following activities must be completed:

- a) Assessment of local institutional capacities to interpret and implement natural resources policy, legislation and guidelines and the development of a Training Plan
- b) Development of training manuals and other materials
- c) Capacity building on the interpretation and implementation of natural resources legislation, policy and guidelines+.

The work of the Consultant is expected to be conducted over a **6-month period**, commencing in **July 2019**.

The Ministry of Natural Resources now invites eligible **Individual Consultants** to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services and should include a Curriculum Vitae.
